

GINGERBREAD HOUSE IN FELT



"Here is my little Gingerbread House which is made in felt and i'm really pleased with it. I hope you enjoy making lots of them in all sorts of colours and themes. Why not make a Beach Hut, Country Cottage, Yule Cottage or Gardener's Shed. The template is adaptable to whatever takes your fancy and I look forward to seeing them all."







You will need:

Brown, red and beige A4 sheets of felt, Seed beads, Embroidery cotton, Superglue and glitter glue, Plastic sparkle gems usually used in cardmaking, Dressmakers Chalk, Buttons and Toy Stuffing.



To make:

- 1. Print out the template so that it fills an A4 size sheet of paper.
- 2. Cut out the pieces from the template.
- 3. Place each piece on the corresponding felt and draw around each of them with chalk.
- 4. Cut out the felt pieces.
- 5. Decorate and embroider each piece before attaching them to one another. Use the superglue to attach the gems and spread a thin layer of glitter glue on the surface of the roof to add some sparkle. Allow to dry.
- 6. Stitch the walls and bottom of the house together using blanket stitch.
- 7. Stuff and then stitch the roof in place using blanket stitch.
